From the editors of this Issue

We are pleased to bring you our most recent issue of the *Quarterly of Latin American Economy and Trade/ Revista Trimestral de Estudios Economia Latinoamericanos*. This issue offers analysis on Latin American political and economic challenges of scholars from Brazil, Mexico and Colombia. From Brazil, Bruno Theodoro Luciano (University of Brasilia- UnB), Karina Lilia Pasquariello Mariano (Universidade Estadual Paulista-Unesp) and Regiane Nitsch Bressan (Universidade Federal de Sao Paulo-Unifesp) discuss the role of regional parliaments in South America measuring the people's perception, levels of the democratic deficit and performance of these institutions.

In their article, Roberto Goulart Menezes, Gabriela Hermosilla and Carlos Solis researchers of Latin American studies at the University of Brasilia provide an analysis on the effects of the creation of the Pacific Alliance over the Brazilian strategy of regional integration in South America. Also, having South America as background, Pio Garcia from Universidad Externado de Colombia, offers insights making a general analysis of the current political landscape in the region. On the economic perspective Andre Moraes Dejuste (National Chengchi University) debates in-depth the implications of the dynamics of international political issues and foreign policy over the Sino-Brazilian bilateral relations.

Finally, from South to North America, Fabricio A. Fonseca-Fernandez (National Chengchi University) offers an interesting analysis on a key figure in Mexican diplomatic history, Gilberto Bosques. Who faced enormous difficulties during of war in Spain and Europe, during the late 1930s and early 1940s.
